Age Limit

The championship is open to boys and girls who are 18 and under throughout the first round of the National Championship on August 5, 2010.

Official Entry Form

All entries must be filed on an official entry form. Entries by phone will not be accepted. A photocopied form is acceptable.

Entry Fee

Completed entry forms, together with applicable entry fee, must be received by the PGA Section contact as noted on this form prior to the entry deadline. Make your check payable and mail it to the applicable PGA Section office.

Application for entry is subject to acceptance by the PGA Section and PGA Tournament Corporation, Inc., the administrator of the Championship. Applicant agrees that, in the event of acceptance, he/she may be rejected at any time thereafter.

The PGA Section and PGA Tournament Corporation, Inc., reserve the right to limit entries, adjust dates, format and other details to fit conditions prevailing at the time of the tournaments.

Rules and Regulations

Regulations will be adhered to pertaining to the NCAA and the National Federation of State High School Associations.

Section Tournament Format

All participants must compete in one of the AGE DIVISIONS listed hereafter. Tournament competition is scratch, stroke play.

Only participants who compete in the older divisions (13-15 and 16-18) will be eligible to qualify for the National Championship. Any junior who wishes to qualify for the National Championship must play 36 holes from the same tees as the 16-18 age division and pay the applicable entry fees.

Caddies

Contestants are not allowed to use caddies at any level of competition.

Section Championships

One Boy and one Girl Champion from each of the 41 PGA Sections will participate in the National Championship. Section Champions are awarded on lowest scratch score for participants in the older age divisions.

I wish to enter the 2010 PGA Section Junior PGA Championship event as noted on this form. The National Championship (if I qualify) will be held at Sycamore Hills Golf Club, Ft. Wayne, Indiana on August 2 - 5, 2010.

The applicant and the parent/guardian certify: 1) that the applicant is an amateur player, as defined by the USGA; 2) that the conditions of entry have been read and understood and approval has been granted in submitting his/her entry; and 3) that the information given in this application is true to the best of his/her knowledge.

In consideration of the applicant's participation in The PGA Section Championships, Qualifiers and The Junior PGA Championship: 1) the applicant and the parent/guardian hereby release The PGA of America, The PGA Section, PGA Tournament Corporation, Inc., Sycamore Hills Golf Club, host sites of PGA Section events and all of each company's respective officers, directors, employees, agents, subsidiaries and affiliates from any and all liability associated either with acts or omissions of such parties, or with accidents or injuries sustained by the applicant or parent/guardian in connection with the tournaments; 2) the applicant grants and assigns his/her individual media/photorights respecting participation in the competition, without exception to the sponsors, PGA of America, PGA Tournament Corporation, Inc., and the PGA Section. Applicant information will be used for internal purposes only in conjunction with PGA of American activities and programs. Additionally, The PGA of America will provide event sponsors of the Junior Series and Junior Championship with the names and mailing addresses of its participants.

It is a condition of participating in this event that the competitor is not permitted to use a motorized golf car during the event competition. Notwithstanding the foregoing, The PGA of America is committed to conducting golf competitions within the parameters of the Americans With Disabilities Act. Players who request relief under the Americans With Disabilities Act and seek a reasonable accommodation for their disability by the use of motorized golf car during the event competition shall be required to submit their request in writing to the Special Board on or before the entry deadline date for review and determination. The Special Board will schedule a hearing to allow the applicant the ability to present evidence to support the applicant's position.
